A few thoughts...about the difference between Devotions and Bible Study

Two months ago, I wrote:

"Where devotions aren't, or never were a habit; then, perhaps it is time to start building that habit."

And I meant it.

This month, I want to take you a step further on the adventure that is knowing the Scriptures and our Master more intimately; and gently suggest, that a Devotional, as important as that may be, is different from personal Bible Study.

A Devotional is created by someone else, somewhere else and very much influenced by their particular way of thinking and situation. Devotionals are wonderful tools that can help us grow and simultaneously encourage us.

Devotionals can be enlightening, insightful, comforting and rewarding.

Especially when you're going through spiritual "dry spells". It is most often during those difficult times that devotionals keep us connected to Scripture.

Still, Devotionals are not the same thing as studying the Bible for yourself.

Personal Bible study is you focusing on a particular section or topic. Personal Bible study is active; rather than the passive of a Devotional. Both allow the Holy Spirit to instruct you. However, with Personal Bible study you are the one allowing the Holy Spirit to prompt you as to choose what you will study. You are the one actively participating with the Holy Spirit to convict, convince and change you.

In undertaking Personal Bible study, you will find a special joy when you read a passage, a chapter or a book. As you seek to gain understanding, getting glimpses of the depth of meaning; being rewarded with a fresh insight; or, simply be stunned at how all the Scriptures apply to you.

Yes, Bible study takes effort. You will need to seek out other resources.

However, the reward is the amazing feeling of seeing the Truth of God's word for yourself.
